

#### **Divide and Disparities in Digital Capabilities**

Variances in digital capabilities among IP offices worldwide

- $\blacksquare manual / semi manual \dots \rightarrow Process optimization$
- struggling back-office  $\dots \rightarrow$  End-to-end / e-services
- incomplete databases  $\dots \rightarrow$  Business intelligence
- basic automation  $\dots \rightarrow$  Advanced SVCs/techs (AI)



#### Impact on the IP Domain

- Internal Efficiencies: Impact on operations, productivity and search / examination quality.
- **Services:** quality of services delivered to applicants and right holders
- **Engagement:** Impact on engagement with global IP systems and databases
- Innovation: hindering national innovation and creativity

### Challenges by Less Advanced IPOs

- Limited funding and infrastructure
- Lack of technical expertise.
- Digital Culture
- Digitally empowered legislation environment




