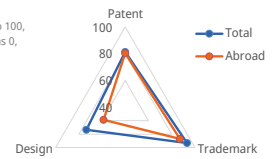




Mexico

Rankings are delineated on a scale of 0 to 100, designating first place as 100, last place as 0, and 50 indicating the midpoint.



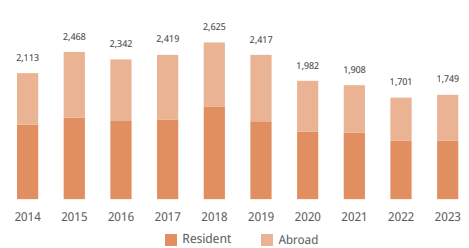

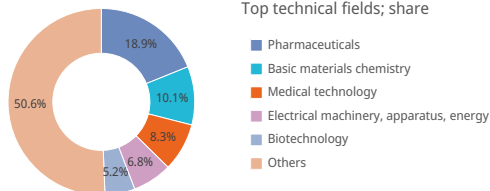

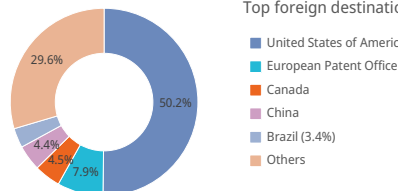

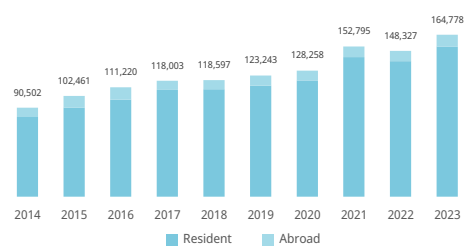

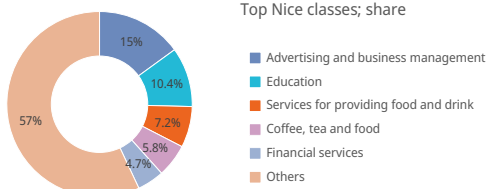

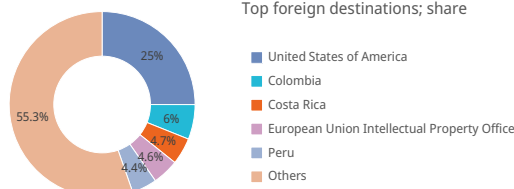
Trademark class count in applications
